

Special Tyre Regulation

ASBK Round 5 – 2024 Phillip Island Grand Prix Circuit, VIC 7-8 September 2024

Dear Riders & Teams,

At the recommendation and request of the ASBK Tyre Homologation Brands, Pirelli, Dunlop, Bridgestone and Michelin. Further in accordance with the Special Tyre Regulation for SBK & SSP classes at ASBK Rd.5 - Phillip Island on 7 and 8 September 2024.

Each ASBK Tyre Homologation Brand must nominate only One (1) Rear Tyre for use in the SBK and SSP class during ASBK Rd.5 – Phillip Island

The use of the One (1) nominated tyre will be applicable for all SBK & SSP Qualifying Sessions and Races only. Not applicable for Practice.

Each ASBK Tyre Homologation Brand must nominate their only One (1) Rear Tyre selection by No Later than 12.40pm Saturday

Please find below the nominated tyre as selected by each ASBK Tyre Homologation Brands, per class.

In accordance with the Special Tyre Regulation for SBK & SSP classes at ASBK Rd.5 - Phillip Island, ONLY the below listed tyre are approved for use in Qualifying and Races.

OFFICIAL TYRE SELECTION:

PIRELLI

Pirelli Tyre Australia & Link International advise the following Pirelli nominated slick tyres for the following classes

Superbike - 200/65R17 SA1126 – tyre listed in current ASBK Tyre Homologation list. Supersport – 190/60R17 SA1128 - tyre listed in current ASBK Tyre Homologation list.

DUNLOP

Dunlop advise the following Dunlop nominated slick tyres for the following classes

Superbike – NO TYRE SELECTED
Supersport – 180/60R17 Sportmax Slick MED (medium compound)

MICHELIN

Michelin advise the following Michelin nominated slick tyres for the following classes

Superbike – Slick Edition (P) 200/55 R17 Supersport – Slick MED/HARD+ 190/60 R17

BRIDGESTONE

Bridgestone advise the following Bridgestone nominated slick tyres for the following classes

SBK - V02RZ Battlax 200/660R17 - SOFT SSPT - V02RZ Battlax 180/655R17 - SOFT
